Culler Lake Sundial, commissioned by the Friends of Baker Park to design a unique, site-specific bronze sundial that invites the visitor to interact with the sculpture in order to determine the time of day – 2019

Fish Filler, commissioned by the Braddock Heights Pool Association to recast the site-specific, filler spout. Originally cast in concrete in 1991, the unique pool-side sculpture was fully restored – 2014

Walk of Fame, Weinberg Center for the Arts, Frederick, Maryland – designed entrance walkway to Frederick's historic performing arts center a pavement design which will include bronze stars honoring key individuals and recognizing donor contributions – 2010.

Community Commons, Point of Rocks, Maryland – working with the community to develop an outdoor public-use space that incorporates the history and significance of the area into a multi-use park that integrates into its natural setting –2018.
